



# Cambridge City Schools



We are looking forward to the 2020-2021 school year and are excited to welcome all of our students, whether it is through the Face-to-face learning option or the full-time Remote learning option.

Face-to-face learning means students will attend class remotely on Mondays and will attend classes in the student's appropriate grade-level school building the other four days of the week (Tuesdays – Fridays).

In the full-time Remote learning option, Chromebooks and internet access will be provided to students who need them for their online learning. Remote learning will consist of online courses and will follow the same or similar curriculum as the in-class courses. Assignments will be required and tests will be given. Students will be held accountable to complete course expectations. Attendance will be monitored and grades will be given based on the student's performance on tests and assignments.

For those planning to return to our face-to-face environment, there are many changes due to the COVID-19 pandemic and there is a lot of information to communicate. We have outlined some district-wide FAQs below:
