As Covid-19 positive diagnoses continue to occur in our community, we believe we need to explain how quarantine is still possible and is occurring within Cambridge City Schools.

Quarantine protocol is completed by the local Health Department and our district assists with contact tracing for this process. As this school year begins, there are similarities and differences between how this protocol is administered from last year compared to this year.
