Meeting Minutes

10:00 - 10:10 am: Welcome and Introductions Around the Room - *Career Navigators*
Madi, Tricia, and Lovel kicked off the meeting and had everyone in the room introduce themselves and where they are from.

10:10 - 10:20 am: YouScience Update/Data Presentation - *Jeremy Vittek & Keri Rosser*
Jeremy presented an update on YouScience and that every school in Guernsey County has implemented YS both at the middle school and high school levels. He also stated that there was a training offered a few months ago and many of the schools attended. ZSC asked to see if they could also purchase the platform to use at the collegiate level for pathways advising. Keri Rosser presented Mark Perna's data about Gen Z's mindset about college and their futures. ZSC also brought up the fact that much of that data is a reflection of traditional 4 year schools, not community colleges.

10:20 - 10:40 am: Zane State College - *Tracey Porter*
ZSC presented non-credit options that are available to local high school students. Options include Drone Mapping and Surveying, Introduction to Education, and Introduction to Health Care. Drone Mapping is two courses that are completed in person and prepares students for the certification exam. Introduction to Education and Health are offered online and include job shadowing and work based learning. Credit is awarded if students matriculate to ZSC.
