Pick-Up



- Dismissal is at 2:15
- K-1 car pick-ups in the top parking lot by the YMCA
- Family & 2nd grade car pick-ups in the back parking lot (across the street from the Armory)
- Walkers will leave through the front doors & will walk to meet their parents in front of the line of buses
- All students will have Dismissal tags. See the CPS Office staff if you don't receive one in the fall (They will be distributed at our Fall Open House)
- Any change to your child's normal dismissal must be called in to the CPS office prior to 1:30

- The first day back to school, please write a note or make a note in the student's agenda book
- If your student has seen a doctor, please send a copy of the doctor's excuse

- IF your child packs their lunch and does not receive a FREE meal, the price for **Milk is 50 cents**
- Menus are posted on cambridgecity.nutrislice.com or on the nutrislice app
- Money can be added to your student's account for milk or additional food beyond the free school meal

PARENTS The Information You Need!

Parents or Legal Guardians will register their child for Kindergarten using Final Forms from the Cambridge City Schools website. When registering your child in Final Forms, Make sure you choose the <u>2024-2025</u> school year!

This detail is extremely important!

If you register your child for the **2023-2024** school year, you will need to complete the entire enrollment process again to re-register your child for the correct school year in Final Forms.

Kindergarten Screening

Your child will be scheduled for a Kindergarten Screening Appointment after you have registered them for Kindergarten in Final Forms.

Kindergarten Screening appointments will take place at the Garfield Administrative Center

Wednesday, April 17th Thursday, April 18th Friday, April 19th 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.



Parents can choose to have another responsible adult bring and wait for their child to complete their scheduled Kindergarten Screening appointment, if necessary.

At Home Readiness Prep



You can help your child improve his or her Kindergartenlevel skills before school starts in the fall. Please practice the following tasks with your child:


- Identify colors, shapes, letters, and numbers
- Follow spoken short directions
- Count items and count to 20 or more
- Use scissors to cut on a straight line or an outlined shape
- Practice writing with upper and lower case letters





Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA-R)

- After you complete your child's Kindergarten registration, he/she will also be scheduled for a Kindergarten Readiness appointment for the fall
- Thursday, August 15th or Friday, August 16th
- An adult will need to bring the student to the **Cambridge Primary School** for this appointment and wait while the student works with one of our teachers to complete sections of the KRA-R.
- When the student completes their work, they will go home with the adult who brought them to the appointment.



Kindergarten Readiness Assessment

- State and federal law requires that all *first-time* Kindergarten students take the Kindergarten Readiness Assessment-Revised (KRA-R)
- The KRA-R is a tool that teachers will use to get to know your child
- It is not designed to rank children by ability but to indicate how ready your child is for learning Ohio's Kindergarten Learning Standards



Kindergarten Readiness Assessment

The KRA-R will measure your child's knowledge and abilities in four areas:

- Social skills
- Language and literacy
- Mathematics
- Physical well-being and motor development





KRA-R



- <u>August 15th & August 16th</u> Short appointments will be scheduled for each student to work with a teacher to complete sections of the KRA-R
- The remainder of the KRA-R will be completed during normal school hours and prior to November 1st
- The information gained from the KRA-R will help teachers and families work together as partners striving to help students be successful in school

- ALL Kindergarten students will attend on Wednesday, 8/21/24 and every day after

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
