COLLEGE VISITS

College Visits need to be approved before attending. Juniors & Seniors: 3 visits per year. We recommend scheduling them on non-school days. Forms are available in the Student Services Office & MUST be completed and returned to Mrs. Bontrager at least 3 days **BEFORE** the visit.

PROGRESS BOOK ACCESS

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Each student is required to complete 40 hours of community service before graduation. **Senior hours are due by Friday, May 7th, in order to graduate.** Students are strongly encouraged to complete at least 20 hours of service by the end of their sophomore year. Senior privileges (second semester senior year) are dependent, in part, on completion of the CS requirement. CS opportunities are emailed to students daily and located on the CHS website. If you have any questions, contact Mr. Bunting or Mrs. Reed at 740-435-1100. The CS form must be completed and signed before turning them into the CS box in Student Services. CS forms are available in the offices and on the CHS website.

SCHOOL FEES
